### HOW TO GET THERE

There are multiple entrances to Clark Hall, but we encourage you to enter through the main entrance off McCormick Road. If you have not been to Brown Library before, please schedule some extra time to locate the room before the first workshop and use the instructions below to help you locate the room.

#### From the Lawn

To reach Clark Hall, exit the Lawn on the southwest corner closest to Cocke Hall and walk west along McCormick Road. Enter the main entrance of the building and walk straight through the foyer and mural room until you enter the Brown Library. After entering the library, turn left and look for the PhD Plus banner on your left.

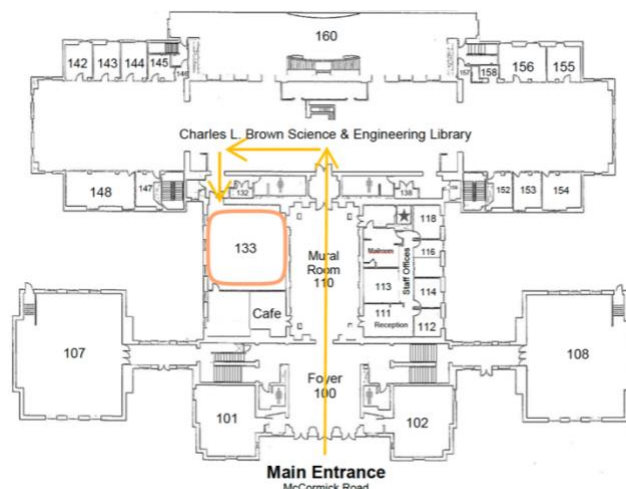
#### From the School of Medicine

At the intersection of JPA, Brandon Avenue, and Ruppel Drive (at the traffic light). Walk up the stairs or ramp toward New Cabell Hall (the larger 5-story building) and continue to walk up the stairs between New Cabell and Wilson Halls until you reach the Lawn. Alternatively, you can enter New Cabell, continuing up the ramp in the stairwell, and take the elevator to the 4<sup>th</sup> floor. Once on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor, exit the building onto the Lawn and follow the instructions above.

#### Disability/ limited mobility access:

There is a ramp located at the main entrance of Clark Hall. The meeting room (classroom 133) is located on the first floor of the building.
